

Team Scoring for the 2008 Dad's Day 5k race/walk

Two separate team competitions will be offered at the 2008 DD5k and they will be scored differently.

Team Competition 1 – This competition is based solely on the number of registered runners. The winner will be the team with the most registered runner. Runners registered in any one of the three races, i.e. the 1K, 3K or the 5K are eligible to join a team. The only requirement is registration in the 2008 DD5k event. There is no requirement for employment or other association with the team name or predominant association of the group.

Team Competition 2 – This competition is based on the traditional age group, gender and race finish scoring system. See definitions and example below.

Definition of Teams: The corporate/municipal teams will be scored based on the following numbers of finishers. Co-ed teams are allowed.

Organization Size (Houston area)	Team Size
Division I (1000+ employees)	8
Division II (5 – 999 employees)	5

An organization can enter an unlimited number of competitors, but only the best 8 or best 5 will count toward the team score. All corporate/municipal-team members must be employed by or associate with the organization they represent. The spouses of the employed corporate/municipal team member may also join the corporate/municipal team. Co-ed teams are allowed.

AGE GROUPS: Age groups for men and women are: 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75 and over. Note that with age-grouped scoring, older runners are just as valuable to your team as younger runners, even though their pace may be slower and their times longer.

SCORING: Teams will be scored using an age-group and gender-weighted scoring system, similar to scoring systems used in other road race events. This system was designed to encourage participation by employees and their spouses of all ages. Scores for the individual competitors will be based on their finish places within their respective age-gender groups.

The best scores (gender-age group finish places) from each corporate team will be used to score the team. Scoring of Division I teams will be based on the best eight runners. And scoring of Division II teams will be based on the best five runners.

EXAMPLE: Consider the following example: a small company, ABC Company, with < 1000 employees, enters six men and three women. The best five individual scores for each age group would be used to calculate the team score.

Company ABC's team score of 17 is based on the five lowest gender-age group finishers. They will be compared to the scores from Company X, Company Y, and so on. Lowest overall score wins first place, second lowest wins second place, etc.

Corporate team scoring will be completed within five days after the race.

Results will be posted on the host website, which is www.TexUsToo.org

Ties are broken by comparing the lowest individual scores for the tied teams. The team with the lower individual score wins. If the tie persists, the next set of low scores is compared, and then the next, until the tie is broken. If the tie still persists, the team with the first runner across the finish line (fastest time) wins the tie-breaker.

TEAM ROSTER: A team roster form can be found below. The team captain must complete the team roster form and submit the roster to at the Team Roster table before 7:30 am on race day (June 14, 2008)

AWARDS: Awards will be based on the number of teams that participate. See table below. Example: If 6 corporate/municipal teams are entered (per Division), trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd Place teams. The 3rd Place team will receive a certificate. If only 3 teams are entered, only the 1st Place winner will receive an award (i.e. trophy).
